

U.S. Department of Education Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II) Reporting Requirement Final Quarterly Report for Student Portion of HEERF II Grant Funds June 30, 2021

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (referred to as "HEERF II") was authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) and signed into law on December 27, 2020. HEERF II provided the University an additional \$7,727,181 in funding for supplemental emergency grants to students.

- UAF received \$7,727,181 (50%) of the total Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II) dollars allocated to the University specifically for emergency financial aid grants.
- As of June 30, 2021, all available funds, \$7,727,181, had been distributed to students.
- As of June 30, 2021, 7,516 students were eligible for and had received an emergency financial aid grant from HEERF II funding.
- All eligible undergraduate, graduate and professional students were awarded HEERF II funding. Award amounts ranged from \$825-\$1,125 based on Expected Family Contribution (EFC) reported in a student's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2020-2021. Students with the greatest need, according to their EFC, received the largest awards.

There was no change in the definition of eligible students or in the communication provided by the University to students concerning the emergency financial aid from that detailed in the University's required 30-day reporting for March 31, 2021.
